PRESTON MARKET PRECINCT

The Victorian Planning Authority (VPA) is reviewing the rules for land use and development within the Preston Market Precinct.

- > Council is working with the VPA to gain a more detailed understanding of what is most important to the community in the Preston Market Precinct. Community input will help inform future planning controls which are the rules for land use and development throughout the Precinct

LEVEL CROSSING REMOVAL PROJECT

The Victorian Government will be removing rail level crossings.

- > Cramer Street, Murray Road, Bell Street and Oakover Road level crossings will be removed, and new Preston and Bell Stations will be constructed.
