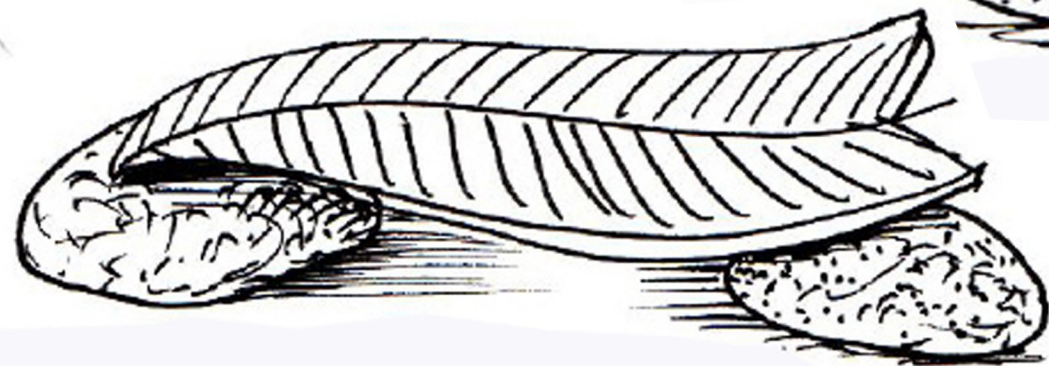

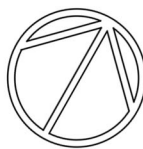

Nature Play Critters

Generally created out of timber or stone these sculptural play critters could be added to the already existing nature play garden.

Possibly using some of the indigenous animals found in the area or the creatures that once lived there but no longer call this place home.

The Critters won't just add some fun and adventure the already existing nature walk, they could also be created to tell one of the many untold stories of some of the animals that lived where the park now is located.



Design Response - Other Communities

Entrance Gateway, Vertical Marker.

These Sculptures would not be a play item, therefore unable to be climbed, but more like a Directional marker to give a reference to a place for people to meet.

They also can act as a gateway /entrance piece to give the indication and understanding you are entering a new space.

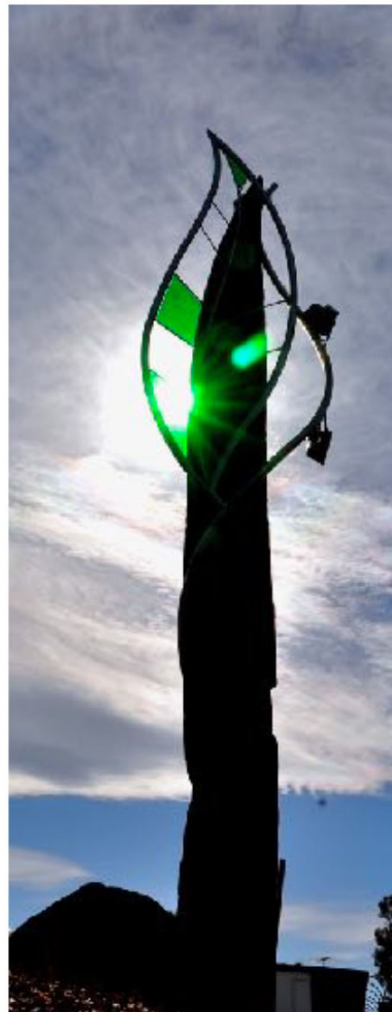


Sculptural Lighting Poles.
