




Edwardes Lake Park Recent Improvements Plan

In 2020 Council decided against proceeding with a full Edwardes Lake Park Masterplan after community consultation showed that proposed improvements were in line with Council's existing direction and policy, and they can be readily considered and progressed through Council's regular renewal, maintenance and open space improvements programs. Below is a plan that highlights the recent completed works as well as some of the proposed changes to the site for future years which complement the feedback received through consultation.



- 1**  **FUTURE**
The finalisation of the design of the new nature based playspace is a major improvement for Edwardes Lake Park and this was identified through community engagement in 2016/2017

- 3**   **FUTURE**
For National Tree day 2021, there will be aquatic planting at the Edgars Creek Wetland and Friends of Edwardes Lake plan to plant several thousand indigenous grasses/groundcovers on the Northern slope of the Athletics Track (Date TBC)



- 4**   **COMPLETE**
Improvements to the athletics track to include resurfacing, new lighting, drinking fountain and shade trees




- 5**  **COMPLETE**
 New public toilet has been constructed, to include a Changing Places facility, adjacent to the Griffiths Street all-abilities playspace






- 8**    **COMPLETE**
Widening of internal paths



- 7**   **COMPLETE**
Resurfacing of the Skate Park



- 6**   **COMPLETE**
New park furniture including seats, picnic suites and bins (including trialling the big belly compacting smart bins)
